

Fun Seekers League Rules

Fall 2025 - 2026

The Fun Seekers league shall consist of 22 teams with a playing strength of **4** members. The league will bowl on Tuesday nights for **36** weeks, ending on May 5, 2026. All scheduled matches will start promptly at 7:00 pm. All members and substitutes will be sanctioned through the USBC and its local associations. No Bowling February 17,2026

1 – MANAGEMENT

The management of this league shall be vested in the Board of Directors, which shall consist of the elected officers and the team captains. The entire league membership shall elect the officers. The Secretary/Treasurer shall be appointed by Park Ten Management. The nominees for election shall be active members of the league. The Board of Directors shall adopt the league rules. A majority shall constitute a quorum.

2 – FEES

League fees shall be \$20.00 per person, \$12.00 will be paid to the bowling establishment and \$8.00 will go to the prize fund. A Secretary fee of \$10.00 a Bowler (\$40.00 per team) must be paid by week 4. Team captains are responsible for collecting all team fees and getting the envelope to the desk by the end of the first game. Sanction fees are \$30 per person, \$25 for 70 over and been in the local USBC for 10 years and \$15 for crossover fee. All sanction fees are due the first night of bowling unless paid in another 2025 – 2026 fall league. Last 2 weeks due by week 12 (November 18, 2025)

3 – PRIZE FUND

4 – LEAGUE FUNDS

An account shall be maintained in the name of Fun Seekers League in which funds will be deposited weekly. The President shall verify the balance each month.

5 – AVERAGES

The members of the league who bowled in the 2024/2025 Fall League shall carry over those averages for the first 9 games of bowling (must have 21 games). If a bowler is new to our league, they must use their highest current 2024/2025 book average for the first 9 games of bowling. If there is no current book, average bowlers will establish the first week.

6 – HANDICAP

Individual handicap allowance shall be 90% of 230.

7 – SUBSTITUES

Substitute bowlers will not be able to bowl on Position Rounds.

8 – LEGAL LINEUP

Two regular member of the team constitutes a legal lineup. Said member must be present before the end of the fifth frame of bowling or the game will be forfeited.

9 – BYE TEAMS / FORFEITURES

If the league has a bye team (odd number of teams) teams must come within 80 pins of their average each game to win points. This rule also applies to known forfeits.

10 - TARDY PLAYERS

A tardy player shall be permitted to bowl the missed frames if they come in before the end of fifth frame. If a bowler comes in after the fifth frame they will start in the next game.

11 – VACANCIES

Vacancy score of 120 with 72 pins handicap will be used.

12 – POSTPONED OR PRE-BOWLED GAMES

Requests for postponements may only be made when a team cannot field a legal lineup. Requests for postponements should be made 48 hours prior to the scheduled time of the match. Team captains are to contact a league officer (Secretary, President or Vice President) and the opposing team captain. If the league officers and the opposing team captain is not informed the games will be forfeited NO EXCEPTIONS. All postponed games shall be made up within 15 days of the scheduled match or before the next position round (if the postponed games fall within the 15-day period). Games not made up in this time frame will be forfeited.

13 – ABSENTEE SCORES

Absentee scores shall be the absentee bowler's average minus 10 pins.

14 – POSITION STANDINGS

Points won shall be determined on a 7-point basis, 2 points for each game won and 1 point for total pins in each match. There will be a position round every 12 weeks.

15 - Position Rounds

Bowlers must accumulate 9 games by the first position round, 18 games by the second & 27 by the third to be eligible to bowl. If a bowler leaves a team the new member must have at least 6 games to bowl position round.
