TOURNAMENT RULES & INFORMATION

(Please read carefully)

To bowl in this tournament, if you do not have credentials which allow you access to the base, the following information must be provided for any individual who plans to participate or attend by no later than September 18th.

1. This tournament is USBC certified. This tournament is open only to members of the Gulf Coast USBC. Gulf Coast USBC Association membership may be purchased at the time of the tournament.
2. Date and time preference will be given as entries are received.
3. This is a handicap tournament for two (2) division's: Open and Women's
4. Re-entries are permitted. Each entry is for one division only as indicated on the entry form. Each entry can win only once in each division.
5. Bowlers must be present thirty (30) minutes prior to their scheduled shift.
6. Substitutions and late entrants must be requested at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled bowling time.
7. The scoring computer printouts will be the official score. Errors in scoring must be reported within one hour after the series has been bowled.
8. Prize fees will be returned 100%.
9. All prizes will be awarded on a handicap basis. The cash prize ratio will be 1 in 6 entries.
10. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between individual average and 210.
11. Entrants will use their **composite published** USBC average (minimum 21 games) from the previous season (2025-2026 Winter season). If entrant does not have a composite published average from last winter season, they may use their composite published USBC league average established in a sanctioned (2025-2026 summer league) that started after March 15th. If the entrant does not have a published or established summer league average, they shall use their current USBC (minimum 21 games) highest average as of the time they enter this tournament. If none of the above applies, the entrant will bowl scratch.
12. Rule 319a2, ten (10) pin increase in average rule for this tournament, does apply.
13. Rule 319a3, bowlers are responsible for verifying their own averages, does apply. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than the correct average thereby resulting in more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. Corrections in averages may be permitted up to completion of the first game of the series.
14. Rule 319d, reporting of prize winnings, does not apply.
15. Rule 322a, concerning handling of late bowlers, does apply.
16. Rule 324b, concerning substitutions, does apply.
17. Any rules not covered on this entry will be referred to the USBC Rulebook.
18. The Tournament Director and/or Board of Directors of Gulf Coast USBC Association reserve the right to accept or reject any and all entries and will decide all questions or disputes arising in the tournament and their decision will be final, unless an appeal is made in accordance with the USBC rules.
